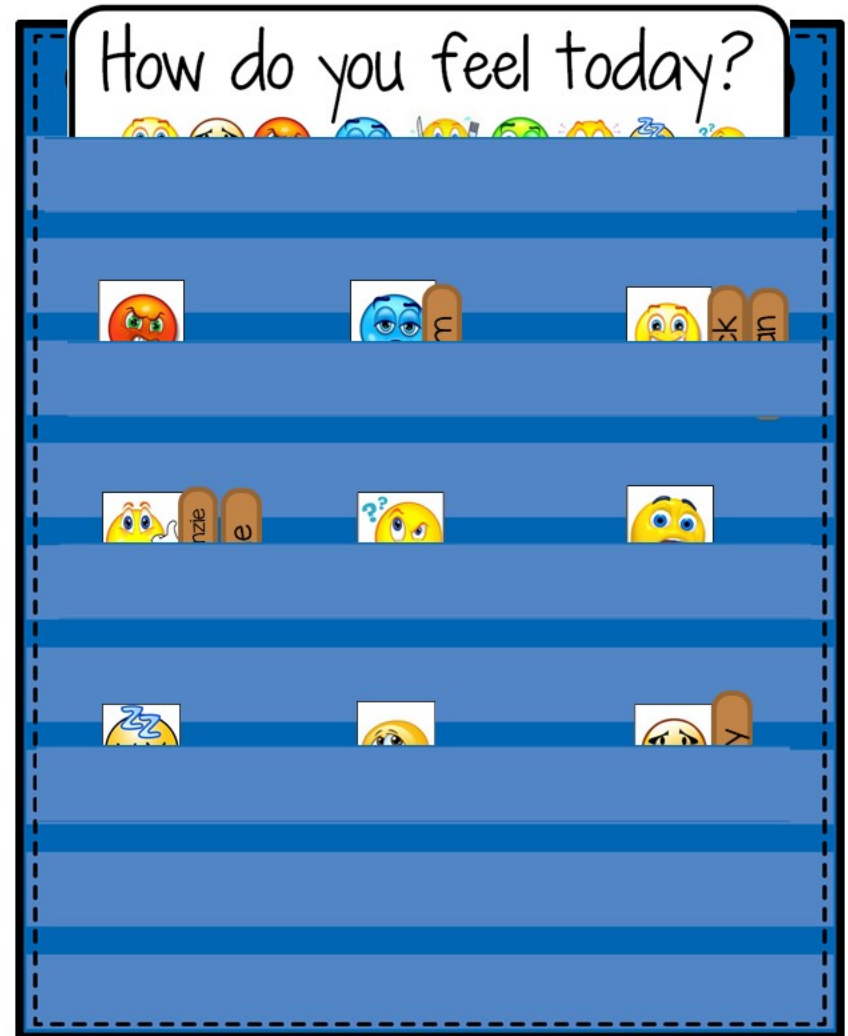


How Do You Feel?

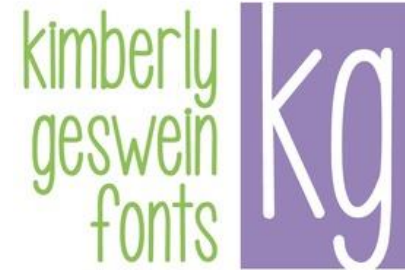
